Students have to submit the record they have maintained on observance of Trial in one Civil Case and one Criminal Case during their internships/Court Visit. The report in this regard be submitted within the dates mentioned in the enclosed notice.
- C. Interviewing techniques and Pre-Trial Preparation and Internship Diary would carry 30 Marks. Each student will have to submit a report in their internships with Lawyer's Office/Legal Aid Office/Law Firm etc and record the proceedings in a diary which will carry 30 marks.

- Q.1. Briefly discuss the functions of State Bar Council. Can a State Bar Council call upon the advocates to cease work?
- Q.2. Can the Bar Council of India debar persons who have completed 45 years of age for being enrolled as an advocate?
- Q.3. Enumerate the qualifications of a person to be admitted as an advocate.
- Q.4. What is professional misconduct and what are the conditions required for applicability of S.35 of Advocates Act?
- Q.5. Discuss the law relating to the power of disciplinary committee to review its own orders.
- Q.6. S.49(1)(c) of the Advocates Act is in substance the professional ethics which an advocate obliged to follow. Keeping this in view discuss the duty of an advocate to his opponent and his fellow colleagues.
- Q.7. Discuss the skill/techniques of an advocate for interviewing his client.
- Q.8. Discuss the importance and object of cross examination.
- Q.9. What do you mean by 'Bench', 'Bar' and 'Court'? Briefly discuss the relationship between Bench and Bar.
- Q.10. What is contempt of court, discuss with case laws?
